Workshop:

- Treasurer Pedersen presented the council with Version 1 of the FY 2026-2027 Budget.
- Council Member Cardoso would like to see the line-by-line expenditure of Workforce Housing moving forward on all regular council meeting reports from Treasurer Pedersen.
- Add “etc.” to line item 602 Office Supplies to more accurately encompass the category.
- At the next budget workshop, the council would like to see the Local Option Tax Request form.
- Pedersen to work with Clerk Fake on coordinating to ensure that events will be responsible for Port-a- pots as the expense is one the city should no longer be covering. Once the new bathrooms are open the expectation is to be able to remove city funded port-a-pots and require events to cover this expense if the population of the event triggers additional restrooms.
- Maintenance & Operations Manager Peters has expressed interest in setting funds for intersection improvements, reclaim parking along Critchfield, dust abatement cost increases, and potential to find funds to build covered storage for the Ice rink/Zamboni as well as the boardwalk in front of the office. Peters would like to look into the cost of leasing a new lawn mower as well.
- Councilmember Cron would like to see an increase in funds for Public & Community Relations to go towards the Square Dance.
- There was general discussion regarding the funds that have been both in the past and in the future allocation to the Stanley Sawtooth Chamber of Commerce. Council Member Cardoso would like to invite the Chamber to the next workshop to get a better understanding of their request and needs for \$25,000 of Local Option Tax funds and how they will be spent.
