Call to Order: (Mayor Botti) Mayor Botti call Public Hearing to order at 10:07 a.m.

Roll Call :

Mayor Steve Botti (Present), Councilmember President Laurii Gadwa: (present via telephone), Councilmember Kim Hernandez (present), Councilmember Tim Cron (present), Councilmember Gabe Cardoso (present). All answered roll call. Also present for the City Clerk/Treasurer Jennifer Hayes.

Mayor Comments:

Purpose of the meeting to present proposed Budget FY2024-2025. Budget spread sheet displays expected expenditures and revenues, as well as summary sheets showing by fund.

Council Comments:

Councilmember Cron wanted to clarify something from the last budget workshop regarding the potential subcontract of treasurer, it had been marked at \$10,000 to help with the transition. Councilmember Cron wanted to know the number that ended up being budgeted for the accounting services line for next year's budget. The number that was entered was \$2400 which would cover one weeks' worth of help from Ken Carlsen if needed.

Budget Hearing FY 2024-2025:

The one correction that needed to be fixed was deleting the line for law enforcement grant. It was decided to remove this line as the Custer County Sheriff's department would be the one responsible for applying for and receiving grants. It was decided and approved to be deleted at the previous budget hearing, a technical correction in that it was not deleted in expenditures. It is noted that it is within the code to reduce a number without having another hearing and that explains the difference between the publication and the ordinance.

Council Moves into Regular Council Meeting at 10:17 A.M.


Purpose: To adopt Proposed Ordinance #221 Fiscal Year 2024-25.
