OLD BUSINESS:

23-2024 Law Enforcement Agreement and Financial Aid Agreement between the City of Stanley, Custer County and Custer County Sheriff's office (tabled in the 9/28/23 meeting):

The agreement being considered is a continuation of the contract that was approved in April 2023, and has an agreement date that starts for the new fiscal year of October 21, 2023.

Councilmember Gadwa moves to approve the current contract as presented.

Councilmember Cron seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

Discuss revised plans for the IDPR Grant application: In the town hall meeting on 9/28/23 the map depicted a trail going through Division of Aeronautics property (in order to have an ADA complaint trail), when we discovered that we would also need permissions from the Forest Service in the form of a special use permit due to an easement they currently have on the Division of Aeronautics property, we quickly realized this would be a very lengthy process & we would not be able to achieve these requirements prior to the Grant application deadline in January. Therefore, we have removed the trail section for the Grant application, we are now only focusing on the sewer line, parking, and restrooms. The grant is only up to \$600,000 for the whole State of Idaho; being realistic we will have to break up the project.

Winterfest 15th annual event – Permissions & requests for the Winterfest Annual Event on 02/16/24 thru 02/17/24: Councilmember Clegg moves to approve the 2024 request with the change on the request dated October 25, 2023, #10, requesting Alpine Peak Level donations of \$500.00 will be changed to McGowen Peak Level of \$250.00. Councilmember Cron seconds. All approve. Motion passes.

Jeff Welker and CJ Sherlock are requesting a donation for their 2nd annual Fat Bike Fondo 2/16/24 thru 2/17/24: Councilmember Cron moves to donate \$250.00 towards the 2024 Fat Bike Fondo event. Councilmember Cardoso seconds. All approve. Motion passes.
